Patient Demographic.

Surgery Rates

How many of your delivers end in a c-section?
Whats the rate of patients that have died under your care?

Birthplan

Are you willing to accommodate my birth-plan as long as it doesn't interfere with a medical emergency?

Natrual Delivery

How DO you feel about natural birthing? How many natrual births have you done?

5

Group Or Private Practice

Will I only be seeing your for my prenatal visits or will I be in rotation with other phycicans ?

6

After Hour Care

How do I contact you between visits? What is protocol when I go into labor?
